

COVID-19 (novel coronavirus) and the CCEB examination

SCREENING QUESTIONS

1. Are you experiencing any of the following symptoms of COVID-19?	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fever • new onset of cough • chills • unexplained fatigue • headache • sore throat • runny nose 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • difficulty breathing • difficulty swallowing • pink eye • digestive issues (nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, stomach pain)
2. To the best of your knowledge, have you had close contact with someone who has a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19?	
3. Do you otherwise have reasonable belief that you may have contracted COVID-19?	
4. Have you travelled internationally within the last 14 days?	

If you answer YES to any of the above questions in the 14 days preceding the examination or on the day of the examination and have not received a medical clearance (in writing), you will not be permitted to enter the testing facility and participate in the examination. Please contact your local health authority.

By attending the CCEB examination, you acknowledge and certify that you have truthfully answered NO to each question.

Additionally, the CCEB reserves the right to deny entry to the testing facility to any candidate, volunteer, or personnel presenting with flu-like symptoms or otherwise appearing to be ill on the examination day.
