### Ontario Proof of Vaccination Requirement ~ IMPORTANT UPDATE

The COVID-19 global pandemic has again created an additional layer of complexity and uncertainty that is beyond the control of the CCEB.

The province of Ontario announced earlier this month that proof of vaccination will be required in select settings starting September 22, 2021.

*“As of September 22, 2021, Ontarians will need to be fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days) and provide their proof of vaccination along with photo ID to access certain public settings and facilities.”* Office of the Premier ~ full text found [here](#)

To comply with the Government of Ontario requirements, the following will apply to **all** CCEB examination administration participants, including candidates, volunteers, and staff. In relation to the upcoming CCEB Component C, clinical examination, October 2, 2021, administration in Hamilton, Ontario you must:

- Provide proof of full vaccination, or
- Medical exemption.

*\*Both as described by the Government of Ontario (see links below).*

#### Important Reminders:

- This is a requirement of the **Government of Ontario**, the CCEB does not have the authority to provide exemptions of any kind.
- Negative COVID-19 tests are not accepted in relation to the activities of the CCEB in Ontario.
